# REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CONSULTANCY SERVICE FOR PREPARATION OF PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT PLANS (PDPS) FOR MPIGI DISTRICT

# 1. Background;

Mpigi District Council has secured funds from the World Bank under the Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area Institution Strengthening Grant to support physical planning activities in Mpigi District. The district Council has prioritized the planning of the entire district. The district is experiencing rapid growth in terms of, population, economic activities, public services and trade. This trend of growth is overwhelming the capacity of available resources (environmental, social, economic, etc). Therefore, this calls for a guiding framework in form of a physical development plan.

The Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area (GKMA) is composed of the administrative areas of Kampala Capital City Authority and it's surrounding three district local governments (Mpigi, Wakiso and Mukono). The GKMA is experiencing rapid urbanisation with a rapid urban population expansion.

The government of Uganda with technical support from the Japanese Government under the Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA) is developing the GKMA Urban Development Master Plan. The master plan designates Mpigi District into two urban planning areas – i.e. the Greater Kampala Urban Growth Area (GKUGA)which covers Mpigi Town Council, Kiringente sub county and Muduma sub county, while the rest of the parts of the district lie outside the GKUGA. These areas include, Subcounties of Kamengo, Buwama, Nkozi, and Kituntu together with the two town councils of Kayabwe and Buwama.

#### 2.0 OBJECTIVE OF THE CONSULTANCY

The overall objective is to prepare Integrated District Physical Development Plans (PDPs) and Urban Physical Development Plans for Mpigi district. With this main objective, these plans are expected to promote both urban and rural development of the district.

## 2.1 SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- a) Prepare full scale District Physical Development Plan (PDP) for the entire district.
- c) Prepare Local Physical Development Plan for the selected Sub County.
- d) Integrate the Physical and socio-economic development proposals outlined in the National Physical Development Plan, the Jinja Kampala Mpigi (JKM) Corridor Physical Development Plan, the Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area Urban Development Master Plan, NPDP III, specific regional development plans and strategies, regional PDPs, district development plans and other development frameworks and aspirations of the district, region and country at large;

- e) Provide proposals for land use, service delivery and key priority areas including settlements, employment centres, infrastructure developments and environmental safeguards that address pressures as a result of urbanization and are Consistent with the National Physical Planning Standards and Guidelines 2011;
- f) Promote and ensure full scale stakeholder engagement (informative and consultative) throughout the planning process;
- g) Redefine urban-rural relations, work out how to strengthen cooperation between urban and rural areas, and explore the positive links between urban and rural economy, society, and environment, in order to promote the sustainable development of urban and rural communities alike in the district.
- h) Formulate strategies for developing modern enterprises including in health, environment, culture, tourism, and high-end service, which together will form functional territories through sustainable social and economic harmonious development.
- i) Formulate strategies on how the district environments with clean water, green landscapes, vibrant biodiversity and ecologies and thriving communities will be conserved and increased.
- j) Develop implementation guidelines of the proposed physical Development Plans
- 4. Mpigi District Local Government now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services in the preparation of the District Physical Development Plan.
- 5. Interested Consultants should provide information in form of brochures, company profiles, etc., demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.
